

VET-SAFETY: Vocational Education & Training Standards in Agriculture, Forestry & Environmental Safety at Heights 2014-2017

1. Overview

VETSAFETY is an Erasmus+ Key Action-2 "Strategic Partnership" project funded by the European Union, focused on the VET sector.

2. Duration

VETSAFETY has a duration of 36 months, starting in September 2014 and ending in August 2017.

3. Objective

The project aims to developing new standards for working at heights within the broader skills sector of the environment.

4. Partnership
