A bit of history

A first version, *Claming Civic Rights and the Practice of Democracy*, submitted in February 2016, was not approved. A thoroughly revised version, RECAST, also backed by the original nineteeen members of the Network of Proposers

(https://www.uma.es/costactionrecast/info/110392/network-proposers) and submitted in November 2016, was approved in June 2017 by the COST Committee of Senior Officials.

Ever since then, over the past four years through its various networking tools (management committee meetings, training schools, working group workshops, short-term scientific missions, communication and dissemination actions, and inclusiveness target countries conference grants), RECAST has distributed more than 400 participation shares (being some participants involved in several activities throughout the Action's time span) among participants from thirty-two countries

Networking

Four capacity-building objectives have oriented RECAST's networking programme:

- 1. Strengthening interdisciplinary cooperation
- 2. Expanding its international membership
- 3. Developing an integrated, interdisciplinary training programme
- 4. Focusing the Action as a networking programme of publications-oriented activities with the added aim of contributing to public debates

To develop this programme, as presented in the Action's Memorandum of Understanding, we've tried to keep balances in research profiles in the humanities and the social sciences, gender, institutions, and countries by launching six calls for applications (for short-term scientific missions and inclusiveness target countries conference grants), three calls for applications for the Training School in the Humanities and the Social Sciences, and twelve calls for papers (three by each of the four working groups: 1: Practices, 2: Languages and Ideologies, 3: Concepts, 4: Debates).

All in all this has made COST Action 16211 work as a redistributive mechanism of networking and international mobility resources and opportunities for a growing number of participants, from 92 in the first grant period to more than 135 in the fourth one.









ITCs, ECIs, and gender balance

Re the implementation of COST policies to promote gender balance and Early Career Investigators (ECI), as well as inclusiveness and excellence (see the list of Inclusiveness Target Countries at https://www.cost.eu/about/cost-strategy/excellence-and-inclusiveness) RECAST has kept the balance reached by September 2018:

This proportion has been the result of networking based on scholarly profiles and shared interests. Some preference has been given to ITC, assuming COST's ITC policy, but keeping the above-mentioned criteria as guidelines. The Action's results prove that high-quality activities can be organised in ITC
