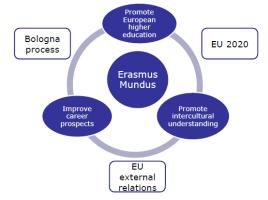

04. OBJECTIVES

- EURASIACAT-TP will offer grantees the following services:

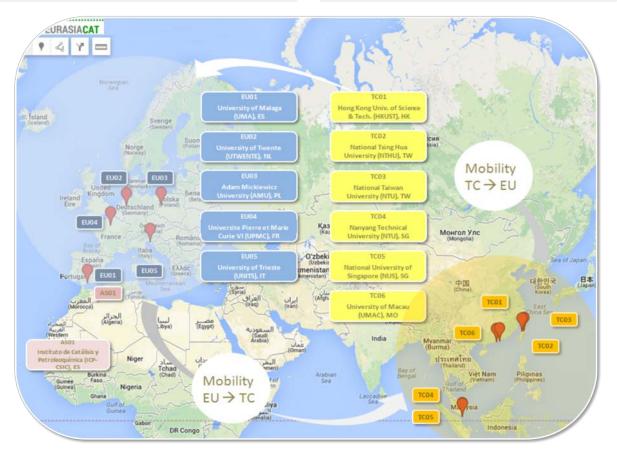

17. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

For all types of grants:

The application form shall be successfully submitted by the established deadline. Under no circumstances shall applications be accepted after the closing of such deadline.

The candidate shall not have been awarded an EMA2 grant for the same purpose of the grant he/she is applying in the context of this project. For instance, should the candidate be applying for a Post-doctoral grant, he/she should not have been awarded (or be awarded) another EMA2 Postdoctoral grant in the context of any other EMA2 project, either previous or simultaneous. However, it would be acceptable if such candidate may have been awarded another EMA2 grant before on condition that it was for a different purpose (e.g. B.Sc., M.Sc., or Ph.D.).

Must be a national of one of the eligible countries;
