Confirmation Letter(COVID-19) on Exchange Student Program

<Must read carefully with the coordinator at your home university and your guardian(ex: pare nts) and submit it after signing a handwritten signature>

1. According to the Korean government's policies, every person from overseas (regardless of nationalities and the departure cities) needs to be quarantined for 15 days after arriving in Korea. Kyonggi University will not provide the dormitory for quarantine. The dormitory will not accommodate students who has not finished 15 days of quarantine. Therefore, students must finish their quarantine in separate accommodations other than the dormitory at Kyonggi University and must pay all fees related to quarantine.

2. If the situation in Korea or abroad related to COVID-19 is not good, Kyonggi University ma y cancel the exchange student program even one day before students' departure. Kyonggi Unive rsity is not responsible for any loss or damage caused by this decision.

3. If the situation related to COVID-19 is not good in Korea, Kyonggi University can force th em to return to their home countries at any time for the safety of foreign exchange students. Kyonggi University is not responsible for any loss or damage caused by this decision.

4. Currently, the Korean government require all people who have visited the areas where clust er infection occurred to be quarantined for a certain period. Therefore, the Korean governmen t, the Korea Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, local public health centers, or Kyon ggi University may request students to be quarantined at any time due to concerns about clust er infection. All foreign exchange students must follow it. if they do not, they have to bear all the disadvantages (deportation order, fines and etc) caused by not following it.

5. Because the situation related to COVID-19 changes very suddenly and rapidly, the Korean Go vernment and Kyonggi University will frequently give notices on policies or guidelines. The d isadvantages (deportation order, fines, and etc) caused by not following policies and guideli nes must be the responsibility of the students.

6. Even if the starting date of the 2021 Fall semester is delayed because of COVID-19, exchan ge students still need to arrive in Korea on the designated day. Should any student would lik e to change the arrival date since the starting date of the 2021 Fall semester is delayed, he or she must know that free pick-up service provided by Kyonggi University will be cancelled. Also, you he or she must solve all the problems related to quarantine like changing accommod

ation reservation etc.

7. Due to COVID-19, Kyonggi University may not be able to provide off-line classes(face-to-fa ce classes). Even if off-line classes are provided, they can be changed to online classes at any time by Kyonggi University's decision.

8. Kyonggi University may not be able to provide students with field trip, Korean culture classes and the other activities because of COVID-19. Individual activities can be restricted as well.

9. If the flight to Korea is delayed or cancelled, students must immediately inform the coord inator at home university. If they are unable to take classes because of the delay and cancel lation of the flight, Kyonggi University will try hard to solve the issue with the student's credit recognition following the guidelines provided by the Korean government or the Ministr y of Education.

10. If the Korean embassy or Korean consulate refuses to issue a visa, Kyonggi University can

not take any action against it.

11. Foreign exchange students agree to be admitted to the quarantine ward immediately if they are found to be infected with COVID-19 during their entry into Korea or during their lives i n Korea. Including the treatment fee. From 2020 Aug 17, foreigners who test positive for the new coronavirus will have to pay for their own treatment if they violate the country's disea se prevention guidelines. Separately, foreigners entering Korea who test positive for the vir us may have to pay their medical treatment, based on the principle of reciprocity between Sou th Korea and other countries.

12. If you are unable to take classes and the test because you got infected with COVID-19, Ky onggi University will try hard to solve the issue with the student's credit recognition foll owing the guidelines provided by the Korean government or the Ministry of Education.

13. Foreign exchange students entering Korea must purchase insurance for studying abroad or t raveling abroad. The period of insurance coverage must be the same as or longer than the peri od of staying in Korea. Students can purchase insurance in their home countries or insurance offered by Kyonggi University. If you are already insured, you must submit a certificate of i nsurance at the request of the Office of International Affairs at Kyonggi University. (Submit in January or February 2021)

14. If it is difficult to participate in the 2021 Fall semester exchange student program due to the COVID-19, you can change your plan to the 2022 Spring semester exchange student progra m or give up the exchange student program itself. The cancellation deadline is January 17 202 1. The cancellation or change on your study plan only can be accepted by the request of the c oordinator at each university.

15. Foreign exchange students will always wear masks and often wash their hands during their stay in Korea to prevent COVID-19 infection, and refrain from visiting crowded areas.

16. Foreign exchange students must obtain the approval from the coordinator at Kyonggi University before traveling abroad or to the other cities in Korea. After finishing traveling abroad, students must complete 15 days of self-isolation regardless of whether they are infected or not. Also, all disadvantages resulting from not obtaining the approval before traveling must be their responsibility.
