Mr. Carlos Jesús Rosa Jiménez is a PhD Contract Professor in Urban and Regional Planning at the University of Málaga.

An Architect who specialised in Building and Town Planning (1996) at the Higher Technical School of Architecture in Seville, where he was granted the III Dragados Prize for Best Final Year Project (1997). He begins his research activity with a research fellowship granted by the Andalusian Government in the aforementioned School (1999-2003). In 2003 he obtains his PhD at the University of Seville and, a year later, is awarded the Extraordinary PhD Prize.

In 2007 he joins the University of Málaga as an Assistant Professor at the Higher Technical School of Architecture, where he performed as Secretary between 2007 and 2010.

He has delivered several lectures in international PhD programmes and has actively participated in numerous national and regional research projects related to tourism, territorial development and historical heritage; the Excellence Project “Las piezas mínimas del Turismo” (Minimal Pieces of Tourism) and “Atlas del Turismo de la Costa del Sol” (Costa del Sol Tourism Atlas) are worthy of mention, as well as other research contracts such as drafting the Special Order and Protection Plan for Ronda’s Historical Centre.

He is currently the Deputy Director of the UPC-UMA Inter-University Institute “Hábitat-Turismo-Territorio” (Habitat-Tourism-Territory).

Since 2012, he is the Deputy Vice-President for Building, Maintenance and Sustainability.
