



University of Málaga's official call for applications dated February 18, 2019 for international mobility places for partner Institutions Students and Staff members for 2018/2020 academic year in the framework of Erasmus + Program KA107 Project (Project nº 2018-1-ES01-KA107-049563 - mobility with partner countries).

Article 1. Object

This Call for applications aims at selecting Students and Staff member of the partner universities who meet the requirements and wish to participate in the Erasmus mobility program + KA107 International Credit Mobility at the University of Malaga.

Erasmus+ offers opportunities for students to study and staff to teach or train in higher education institutions (HEIs) beyond Europe. It also makes available the same opportunities for staff and students from countries beyond Europe to come to participating HEIs in Europe. This is well known as International Credit Mobility (hereinafter cited as ICM) and this is an activity under Key Action 1 (KA107).

Under this mobility, students at any level are able to study abroad for a limited period of 3 to 5 months for which credits are obtained. After the mobility phase, the students return to their sending institution to complete their studies and get recognition for the obtained credits. Similarly, staff can spend a teaching and/or training period abroad for up to 2 months.

Article 2. Financing of the Program

The funding for mobility grants within the framework of this Call comes from funds of the European Commission, which are managed by the Spanish Service for the Internationalization of Education (SEPIE).

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Article 3.- Duration of Mobility

- **Student:** The duration of the mobility period is 5 months.
- **Staff Teaching/Training:** The total duration of the mobility period is 5 days and 2 days for travel. A minimum of 8 teaching hours per week has to be respected.

All mobilities must be finished before July 31st, 2020.

Article 4.- Placements and Partner Institutions.

Article 5.- Eligibility.

- To be National of any of the partner countries published in the call for applications.
- To be registered at the same level of studies that is applying for (for students), or work (for staff), in one of the partner universities at application stage.

Article 6.- Application.

Candidates may apply up in this application online tool (apolo.uma.es) and submit the following documents (in English):

For the registration phase:

- ID Card or passport
- Proof of connection (copy of the enrolment at the same level of studies for students and work contract for staff)

For the application phase:

- Planned study or work programme for the stay
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Academic record (only students)
- Invitation Letter
- Language Certificate (Optional for Staff)

Application Period: from February 19th to March 19th, 2019.

It's compulsory to be registered on the platform, before the deadline.



Article 7.- Selection Criteria.

Applicants must fulfil the following criteria:

- To submit the online application before the established deadline.
- To be National of any of the partner countries published in the call for applications.
- To be registered at the same level of studies that is applying for (for students), or work (for staff), in one of the partner universities at application stage.
- Academic requirements: To be accepted and assessed positively (<50%) by the home and host universities, according to the following criteria:

Selection Criteria	Percentage (%)
Planned study or work programme for the stay	50%
CV and academic record (only students)	50%

Language requirements: UMA will not request documents providing the level of language to the applicants, however host institutions will ensure that candidates meet the language requirements to be able to take advantage of the mobility period. Language certificate will be considered in the assessment however is not compulsory for staff. Spanish native speakers who are interested on mobilities to Spanish spoken countries do not need to provide language certificates.

Article 8. Experts Commission.

All applications will be assessed by an Experts Commission from each thematic field at home and host universities with a 50% of the final mark respectively and the lists of the provisional and definitive results will be published here (<https://www.uma.es/icm/cms/menu/calls/2018-2019/>).

For a better implementation of the project, academic coordinators of partner universities who apply for a placement will be given priority against other staff members.

All selected candidates must comply with the requirements of both home and host university regarding all the requested documents and proofs of the stay

Article 9.- Conflict

Selected candidates won't be able to participate in any other program developed in the same period.

Grants in this call will be compatible with previous Erasmus + stays (study/ traineeship), Erasmus+ or Erasmus-Mundus. The same student may participate in mobility periods totaling up to 12 months maximum per each cycle of study independently of the number and type of mobility activities, except for Medicine and Architecture with 24 months of stay maximum.



Article 10.- Revocation of an Award

University may revoke an award or a place granted with a full or partial refund of the grant when the conditions prescribed for admission to the award have not been fulfilled or irregularities or fraud in the award procedure.

Article 11.- Jurisdiction

This call will be subject to the specific norms in this publication and the rules currently in force.
