Fabián Arrebola Pérez graduated in Telecommunications Engineering from the Polytechnic University of Madrid. He is tenured professor of the University of Malaga in the Technology Department, and since May 2012 has been the Head of the Higher Technical School of Telecommunications Engineering.

In 1988 he began his professional career as a real-time software engineer in the Radar Division of CESELSA (Indra). In 1990 he joined the University of Malaga. His research focuses on Multiresolution Vision Systems and Characterization of Digital Contours, crediting 2 six-year research periods.

In addition, he has extensive experience in knowledge transfer, participating in numerous projects with companies such as Telefónica R+ D (within the framework of the National Broadband Plan and in the area of multimedia systems), ELIOP S.A. (in the field of Computer Vision and Digital Image Processing) and Fujitsu (in the development of software applications).

With regard to university management, he was Deputy Head of Coordination (2003-2004) and Deputy Head of Research and Mobility Coordinator (2004-2008) at the Higher Technical School of Telecommunications. In March 2008 he was elected Head of the Department of Electronics Technology at the University of Malaga and was reelected in February 2012.
