Ernesto Pimentel has been full professor of Programming Languages and Systems at the University of Malaga since 2003.

He obtained a B.Sc. in Mathematics in 1988, and in 1989 joined the Department of Programming Languages and Computer Science at the University of Malaga. He received his PhD in Computer Science in 1993.

From the beginning of his career, he has combined teaching and research with management, holding positions in both academic areas (Head of the Department of Programming Languages and Computer Science and Head of the Higher Technical School of Computer Engineering, among others), and the evaluation of research projects and university degrees (General Directorate of Research Projects, ANECA and other evaluation agencies). In addition, he has served on various international committees such as the European Research Council for Informatics and Mathematics.

Ernesto Pimentel Sánchez undertakes teaching at degree, Master's and PhD level. He has participated in and led several innovative teaching projects and pilot schemes, written textbooks and edited translations of textbooks, and has contributed to various publications regarding education in Computer Science.

He has been education coordinator of degree, Masters and PhD courses, and has directed several doctoral dissertations. His research is currently focused on service-oriented and component-based software engineering and developing cloud computing technologies. Since 1995, he has lead research projects funded by both national and European calls, and has participated in a number of technology transfer agreements. He is author of numerous articles published in international journals together with presentations and conference proceedings at international congresses. Moreover, he is on a large number of diverse scientific committees, editorial boards of magazines, executive committees and congress programme committees.
