

Hasta el 1 de noviembre oportunidad de participar en el programa S.P.A.C.E de la Vives University of Applied Sciences. Belgium

For the 14th year in a row VIVES University of Applied Sciences is organizing the English conducted international programme S.P.A.C.E. (Social Pedagogical Art & Creativity Exploration). We would be very pleased to welcome students for the Spring term 2023 at our Department of Applied Social Studies in Kortrijk, Belgium.

The S.P.A.C.E.-programme covers one semester of 30 ECTS (from the beginning of February till the end of June 2023). S.P.A.C.E. explores how art and creativity are applied in social/pedagogical settings and how the arts sector focusses on participation and inclusion: artistic ateliers for people with and without a disability, creative projects in prisons or refugee camps, social-artistic work in neighbourhoods, creative youth work, art from CRIP artists, ... An interesting programme for students in Social Work, Social Pedagogy, Psychology, Social Services, Social Educational Care Work, (Special) Education, Art Studies, Culture & Media Education... Theoretical lessons, practical creative workshops, guest lectures, study visits and project work are a part of the programme.

There are some changes in the programme. We deliberately chose to offer students even more active and creative sessions: the former course unit 'Methods on Art & Creativity' increased from 6 to 8 credits and is now named 'ARTillery: Art Based Labs + Reflection & Research'. The course unit 'Reflections & Theory on Art and Creativity' will be called 'Philosophy on Art & Creativity' next year.

So the programme of 30 ECTS for 2023 will contain:

- Global Sustainability and Engagement (3 ECTS)
- Philosophy on Arts & Creativity (3 ECTS)
- ARTillery (8 ECTS): 2 parts: Art-Based Labs (5) + Reflection & Research (3)
- Sector Exploration and Study Visits (4 ECTS)
- Group Project (12 ECTS)
