


#### PARTNER COORDINATORS OF THE ERASMUS+ ICM KA107 2019 COMMIT TO:



#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Application



It is an online platform at UMA where to apply for a placement. On the website you will find a detailed guide on how it works for <u>Outgoing</u> & <u>Incoming applicants</u>.

#### **REGISTRATION**

ID card/Passport

| **Proof of enrollment** at your home university (ONLY for **Incoming** students)

Planned study and research programme for the stay.

| **Academic record** from the University degree through which you have accessed to the postgraduate mobility studies.

| **Invitation Letter** (an acceptance email is satisfactory). In the case of PhD student, it is necessary that the document has the acceptance of the thesis supervisor and the commitment of the tutor from the host University.

#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Planned of study /Research Program for the stay

A maximum of **7500 characters** will be distributed, with spaces included, which will be distributed, according to the applicant's own criteria among the different sections of the studies or research plan:

Overall objectives of the mobility (Master + PhD)

Added value of the mobility (in the context of the modernisation and internationalisation strategies of the institutions involved) (only PhD)

Content of the research programme (Master + PhD)

Expected outcomes and impact (Master + PhD)

#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Major Requirements

#### **INCOMING**

To submit the online application before the established **deadline**.

To be **national** of any of the partner countries published on the call for application.

To be registered at the **same level of studies** that you are applying for during the application and mobility period.

#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Major Requirements

#### **OUTGOING**

The definitive award of the granted place depends on the fulfillment of the **requirements** of the host university, as well as the formalization of the application and/or the enrollment within its established deadline.

The student mobility must take place during the 2nd semester of the academic year 2020/2021 or during any of the semesters of 2021/2022.

#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Periods and Deadlines

**MOBILITY TERM:** 5 months

MOBILITY MUST BE EXECUTED BY 31th July 2022

**REGISTRATION AND APPLICATION PERIOD:** 

15/09/2020 - 11/10/2020 (23:59 GMT+1)



#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Resolution

After the registration and application period, a **provisional list of eligible and excluded candidates** will be published based on the requirements states on the call.

A correction period of 10 working days to amend and improve the application

Publication of the definitive list of eligible and excluded candidates.

Eligible applications will be assessed during the **evaluation period** for the academic responsible person at the origin institution, as well as its counterpart at the UMA.

Once evaluated by both universities, the **provisional list of selected and excluded candidates** will be published with detailed information about the application scores, and waiting list.

#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Resolution

**Complaints** to the provisional lists of selected and excluded candidates (Period to be established)

Publication of definitive list of selected and excluded candidates.

Published the definitive lists, if there are still any unallocated grants, it could be requested on the APOLO platform **apolo.uma.es** following the instructions "Registration and Application"

#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Conflicts



Selected candidates cannot participate in any other mobility program developed in the same period.



Grants in this call will be compatible with previous Erasmus+ mobility (study/traineeship), Erasmus+ or Erasmus-Mundus. The same student may participate in mobility periods totaling up to 12 months maximum per each study cycle independently of the number and type of mobility, except for **Medicine and Architecture** with **24 months** of stay maximum.

#### **POSTGRADUATE.** Revocation.

The allocation of the places and mobility aids regulated in this call can be revoked, with a **full or partial reimbursement** of the grant, due to breach of obligations of the beneficiary. And also when the conditions prescribed for admission to the award, have not been fulfilled or irregularities or fraud in the award procedure have been detected.

Candidates must be accepted and positively assessed ( $\geq 50$ ), both by the University of Malaga and by the Partner University, according to the following criteria:
