In this section, we are delighted to inform you about the teaching and research staff opportunities in the Department of Applied Economics offered by the University of Málaga in the field of *Tourism*. We teach the following subjects within the hospitality management degree:

- Structure and Analysis of the Gastronomic and Hotel Markets

The hiring process is highly regulated and we need to follow the regulations imposed by the University of Malaga and each of its teaching centres. According to that regulation, positive evaluations to be a Phd Lecturer provided by ANECA is a compulsory prerequisite. Additionally, academic education, teaching experience related to tourism, articles published in indexed journals and research visits to highly regarded universities and research centres are highly appreciated. As we use Spanish to teach most subjects within our department, fluency in Spanish will be required and if you are a non-Spanish citizen, an official certificate of your command of this language may be required. We highly recommend all potential

candidates to carefully read the regulations related to the application process, deadlines and values assigned to each merit.
