Five is the maximum number of classes a student can take (this equates to 15 credit hours in the North American system). We generally recommend that the students take 3 or 4 classes as 5 classes is extremely demanding. | |
| Standard Course Load for an Academic Year | With 3-5 classes per semester, a full academic course load ranges from 6-10 classes over two terms (Fall and Winter terms). | |

| Registration for Courses | Exchange students are <u>not</u> permitted to register themselves in classes. A student may not register for classes until an academic advisor has been in contact with them. | |

| Language Certificate | All incoming exchange students do not have to submit proof of English Language Proficiency. However, it is the students' responsibility that they are comfortable with learning in a completely English environment. Lectures are all taught in English. It is highly recommended that one of these ELP tests are met. TOEFL : Internet based (83); Reading (20); Listening (20); Speaking (20); Writing (20). IELTS : Overall Band score of 6.5, with no band less than 6.0. **Note: Nursing requires a TOEFL band of 90. Reading & Writing 20; Listening 22; Speaking 26 IELTS : All bands 6 with no bands less than 5. |
