## Korean Language Program

- The INUKLI Korean Language Program is designed to prepare international students for successful study at the undergraduate/graduate or business level in Korea.
- •The KLP is a year-round program consisting of four terms (Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter).
- Each term is 10 weeks long, with a total of 200 instructional hours.
- Monday to Friday (5 days a week) / 9:00~12:50(4 hours a day).
- Each term provides various Korean cultural programs along with intensive KLP focusing on language skills of speaking, listening, writing, and reading.
- The KLP provides 6 levels of beginner (Level 1~2), Intermediate (Level 3~4), Advanced (Level 5~6)

Certificates	<ul> <li>Certificates are awarded to students who have scored over 60 points in their academic studies, and have successfully attended 80% or more of their classes. For those with superior grades, a scholarship will be awarded.</li> </ul>

Obtaining TOPIK, or Test of Proficiency in Korean LEVEL 3 or 4 is required for admission of Korean Universities

- \* Notarization should be translated in English or Korean.
- \*\* Those residing in Korea with appropriate visas like F-2, F-4, E-2, C-3, D-4, etc. can apply for the course two weeks before class begins. To secure your registration, please apply as soon as possible since space is limited.

# CaseRefund Policy• Apply for a refund before the first day of the term.<br/>• Apply for a refund during the first week of the term.<br/>• Apply for a refund after the first week of the term.• 100 percent of the tuition will be refunded<br/>• 70 percent of the tuition will be refunded<br/>• No tuition will be refunded

\* Bank transaction fees are at recipient's expense and admission fee is not refundable.

\* A student should write an 'application for tuition refund' . (Download Form at http://inukli.inu.ac.kr)

\* A student should submit the original acceptance letter or verifiable confirmation documents stating the special circumstances or

visa rejection. Any false or forged documentation will be considered null and void, and any refund will be cancelled.










Off-Campus Accommodation	Korean language students shall find individual accommodations off–campus. The monthly rent for off–campus accommodation is about 350,000~450,000 krw a month(180,000~230,000krw if shared by two students). Students can share a room with friends to save living expenses. If necessary, assistance, upon request, will be provided to students finding accommodations. – Location : 15 ~ 40 minutes by subway – Type : Small Studio(ONE–ROOM) or Single Studio(GositeI) – Monthly Rent : Small Studio (ONE–ROOM) → about 350,000~450,000 krw (180,000~230,000krw if shared by two students). Single Studio (GositeI) → about 280,000~350,000 krw per person
Health Insurance	Starting January 2013, it is mandatory for all international students (D–4 visa) to have health insurance coverage throughout their studies at INUKLI. International students must, by INUKLI health insurance requirements, show proof of health insurance coverage, prior to attending INUKLI classes or sign up for health insurance as soon as he/she receives alien registration card. – Yearly insurance premium rates range 120,000 to 180,000 krw according to one's age.
Buddy Program	The Buddy Program is designed to assist international students in becoming familiar with INUKLI and Korean life. Serve as your point–of–contact for answering any questions about Korean life and others you may have. Show you around the University and its facilities. I linguistic support, cultural guidance and information about life at INUKLI. I help settling into INUKLI
Scholarships	A "General Scholarship" of 300,000 krw (per term) could be awarded to some qualified students who have achieved excellent grades (i.e. a score of 90 or above in all areas of study with an attendance rate of 90% or above throughout the term). Other scholarships will be granted to qualified students according to the University policy.
Cultural Programs	Field trips and cultural activities are an integral part of the INUKLI Korean Language Program. By adding cultural content, the program further enhances students' understanding of Korean culture. 1 or 2 field trips and activity classes per term are included. Each term provides various Korean cultural programs for students. (Excursion to Folk Village, royal palaces, and amusement parks, watching performances, craft activities, etc.
