   Incoming students who will attend practical courses (practicum) at the Faculty of Medicine or Health Sciences must bring from home countries where they are nationals a Liability Insurance.
- Students who will conduct practical courses with minors
   Incoming students who will attend practical courses (practicum) with minors must bring from home countries where they are nationals (if they have dual citizenship of both countries), a negative certificate from the Central Registry of Sexual Offenders, or a criminal record, and failing that, a consular certificate of good standing.

#### VISA

Non European Students (Non- European Mobilities)

In order to help students for the Non- European Mobilities in their visa procedures, Original Acceptance Letter will be able for downloading by the home Coordinator once students are nominated. Depending on the visa obtained at the Spanish Embassy/Consulate in their home country, the student may need to attend to the Police Station within the month after their arrival. Students may inform themselves about the need of this procedure when they apply for the visa.
