The first two courses focus on students obtaining basic knowledge of the fundamental health aspects of this profession. Although there are specific physical therapy subjects in the first and second years, it is in the third and fourth years that the knowledge and techniques of Physiotherapy are studied in depth. The external internships are carried out in different public and private health institutions (hospitals, early intervention centres, sports centres) during the third and fourth years under the supervision of a physical therapist. Finally, in the 4th year, the Final Degree Project is carried out, where students integrate the knowledge of the whole degree oriented towards Physiotherapy.

Both classes and practical seminars on the subjects and external internships are held in the mornings and afternoons.
