<KBS World Radio Special Event> Korean Language Video Contest

'Speak In Korean'

Eligibility

- Foreign nationals living outside of Korea (Naturalized Koreans and foreign nationals of Korean descent are not eligible.)
- Applicants must have a valid passport and be eligible for international travel

How to Enter the Contest

- Preliminaries: Pick one of the two given topics. Write a speech in Korean on the topic and film yourself giving the speech. Submit both the video and the script of your speech.
- TOP 10: The Top 10 participants will be given missions, about which they will hold video conversations with KBS announcers. The participants will be judged on their communications skills in Korean.
- Final Round: The Top 3 participants must write a speech in Korean on a given topic using provided vocabulary. The participants then must film themselves giving the speech and submit the video.

Awards

- Grand Prize (1 Person)
 - A round-trip ticket to Korea, all expenses paid for a 6-day visit
 - A commemorative plaque
 - Chances to participate in various KBS World Radio's programs and experience diverse Korean culture
- Runner-up and Third Place Prizes (1 Person Each)
 Souvenirs

All participants will be placed in a drawing for souvenirs.

Note

- The speech script must be written by the participant.
- The participant's face must be recognizable on the video.
- A script or a video previously submitted to other contests may not be used.
- If a script or a video will be disqualified if found to have won a prize in other contests. The accolades will be revoke if the winners' scripts or videos are later found to have won a prize in other contests.
- The Grand Prize winner must be able to travel to Korea in September.

- * The length of the video must be at least 3 minutes. The speech in Korean must be at least one and a half minutes.

Q : Can foreign nationals residing in Korea participate in the contest?

A: No. Applicants must reside outside of Korea.

Q: What will the applicants be judged on?

A: Applicants will be judged on there vocabulary, pronunciation, attitude, grammar, and the contents of the speech. The applicants' understanding of Korea is also important in the TOP 10 and final rounds.

Q: How will the participants be graded?

A: Winners will be selected by two criteria: the videos' number of views + judges' evaluation.

Q: Could one applicant apply twice using two different videos?

A: No. Each applicant may submit one video per person.

Q: What must be included on the video?

A: The video must include at least 1 minute and 30 seconds of the participant speaking in Korean. Bonus points may be awarded to videos that feature fun and outstanding ideas.

Q: Can minors apply?

A: Yes. Minors may apply to the contest. However, if a minor wins the Grand Prize, air fare or other expenses for a guardian will not be provided by KBS. Q: Are there any documents that must be submitted by the contest participants?

A: Participants who pass the preliminaries must submit a copy of their passports. Minors must also submit a written consent of a guardian.

O: How will the winners be notified?

A: Winners will be announced on our web site. The TOP 10 and TOP 3 participants will also be notified individually via the e-mail address submitted by each participant.

Q: Are there any conditions for visiting Korea?

A: One must be eligible for international travel and hold a valid passport. The Korea visit may be cancelled if these conditions are not met by the prize winner.

Q: What kind of programs will be provided during the prize winner's visit to Korea?

A: The prize winner will get a chance to have a Korean lesson with KBS announcers, go on a Seoul City tour, and also take part in KBS World Radio's special programs, among others.

Q: What happens if a submitted video is in violation of a copyright law?

A: Any plagiarized works or works that had been awarded in other contests will be disqualified. The maker of the video will be responsible for any copyright infringement committed on and/or by the video. A video or a script submitted may be disqualified if it is suspected of copyright infringement. If copyright infringement is

proved after the script or video in question had won a prize, the accolades will be revoked.
