



# UNIVERSIDAD DE MÁLAGA CALL, DATED 10<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2022 FOR TRAINING AND TEACHING STAYS AT UNIVERSIDAD DE MÁLAGA, WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE EUROPEAN PROGRAMME ERASMUS+ KA107 Project (2020-1-ES01-KA107-080884) ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023

#### 1.Purpose of the Call

The present call is based on the funding awarded to the Universidad de Málaga (UMA) for mobility projects with EU-partner countries under Key Action 107 of the Erasmus+ Programme. Exchanges and it will be implemented during 2022-2023 academic year.

The purpose of this call for applications is to select training and research staff from partner countries who, meeting the requirements wish to participate in mobility stays at the Universidad de Málaga within the framework of Erasmus+ KA 107 International Dimension mobility program, subject to the acceptance of the candidate by the Universidad de Málaga and in accordance with the provisions of the <a href="interinstitutional agreements signed (http://u.uma.es/cZD/">interinstitutional agreements signed (http://u.uma.es/cZD/</a>) between the aforementioned institutions and the Universidad de Málaga.

#### 2. Finance

#### The financial aid includes:

- <u>Individual support for staff</u>. The amount is established according to the country of
  destination and the actual number of days of stay at the Host University. In Spain
  the amount is 160 euros per day. The eligible period is 5 days of stay + 2 days of
  travel (1 day departure and 1 day return). In total, 7 eligible days, for an amount of
  1,120 euros.
- Additional support for travel expenses. This amount is calculated according to the following distance bands:

The project will cover a return ticket from home to the host university for all grantees with a fixed amount depending on the travel distance calculation made through the EACEA online tool:

Travel distance	Amount per participant
Between 10 and 99 Km	20 Euros
Between 100 and 499 km	180 Euros
Between 500 and 1999 km	275 Euros
Between 2000 and 2999 km	360 Euros
Between 3000 and 3999 km	530 Euros
Between 4000 and 7999 km	820 Euros
8000 km or more	1.500 Euros

Scholarships will be paid to the beneficiaries by the Universidad de Málaga upon arrival. The grant will be paid via a bank cheque upon arrival and signature of the Grant Agreement.







#### 3. Application procedure and resolution of the mobility call.

UMA, the partner universities and the applicants will comply with the following:

- The partner universities will prepare their own mobility calls where they will respect the requirements according with this call and the guidelines of Erasmus+ KA 107.
- The partner universities will publish on their websites and announce in their university communities these mobility calls.
- 3. Applicants from partner universities shall provide all necessary documents to their International Relations Office before the date established internally by this Office.
- 4. The partner universities will choose among their applicants with the highest score, according to the established scale, which should have been duly announced in the mobility call text published by each university.
- 5. The partner universities will send the required documents through UMA on-line application form (<a href="http://u.uma.es/cZv/">http://u.uma.es/cZv/</a>) depending of the period of the stay (from October 22-July, 23) by 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023 at the latest. It is recommended, especially in those countries where the deadlines for obtaining a visa are longer, to make the nomination before the established deadline.
- Once the documents from the partner universities have been received and verified, the selected candidates will receive an email with instructions on how to proceed.
- At least 20 days before the start of their stay, the selected person should contact the University of Málaga through the email <u>icm@uma.es</u> to start the admission process (article 4). The final acceptance will be subject to the fulfillment of the administrative procedures.
- 8. UMA will publish a list of selected participants with the grant Erasmus+ in <a href="http://u.uma.es/cZw/">http://u.uma.es/cZw/</a> and will be announced to the partner universities by e-mail.
- 9. Once all the documents have been received, UMA will send an invitation letter to the participants for the processing of the corresponding visa in their country of origin. Any delay in providing the required documents or accurate information will result in a delay in the sending of the acceptance letters to the candidates for the visa process.
- 10. Participants will arrange their own visa, take out a travel insurance (preferably the one taken out by UMA), look for accommodation and buy tickets to arrive in Málaga on time.
- 11. All mobilities must be executed before 31 July 2023.

### 3.1. Prior acceptance procedure for a place offered by UMA

In order to be able to participate in the selection process, the interested person must be previously accepted in one of the places offered by Universidad de Málaga for the academic year 22/23.

#### 3.2. Selection procedure by the home university

The entire pre-selection process at the home university will comply with the criteria of transparency, equal opportunities for applicants and the <u>inter-institutional agreements</u> (http://u.uma.es/cZD/ (Annex I).

The specific pre-selection criteria will be drawn up and published on the web pages and social networks of each of the home universities and will be disseminated, as far as possible, in the local and regional media.







Specific requisites for teaching and staff eligibility:

- To submit a Mobility Agreement duly signed by all the parties (the candidate, the sending and the receiving institution).
- To have a contractual relationship with their home institution at the time of application and during the mobility. Proof of their contractual relationship or connection with the home institution will be requested to the candidate during the procedure for nomination (article 3.4).

# 3.4. Procedure for the nominations of participants to the Universidad de Málaga.

To formalize the nomination, the partner university must complete the online application form on UMA website and upload to the application the required documents listed below before 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023 at the latest:

 <u>Letter of Nomination and Absence of conflicts of interest</u> (Annex II) signed and stamped PDF format.





The partner universities can establish, in addition to the list of nominees previously agreed in the interinstitutional agreement, a reserve list. In the event that all places are not filled, UMA will proceed to evaluate the reserve list of each university.

- · Proof of candidate merits and inclusion of criteria.
- <u>Proof of the contractual relationship or proof of connection and translation of the document only if is written in a language other than Spanish, English or French.</u>
- Mobility Agreement duly signed by all the parties (the applicant, the home coordinator and the person who will supervise the work plan at the Universidad de Málaga.

Candidates are recommended to contact first with <u>University Contact at UMA</u> ( <a href="http://u.uma.es/cZz/">http://u.uma.es/cZz/</a>) for the drafting of the mobility agreement.

- Call for application at home university (Document)
- Proof of Dissemination of the Call for Applications at the home university (Web/ Social Media)

Once the nomination period has been closed, the Evaluation Commission of the International Relations Office will distribute the scholarships equitably, considering the score assigned to each candidate by the home university, the supporting documentation provided in the nomination, and the funds available for each partner university.

In the event that the number of applicants is higher than the number of grant places assigned to each country, participants who have not obtained a grant can apply for a "Zero Grant" Participants with a "Zero Grant" will have the same rights and obligations as participants with a full grant but will not receive Erasmus+ funding.

Candidates can design their own work plan and contact <u>department</u> ( <u>http://u.uma.es/cZA/</u>) or <u>University Contact at UMA</u> ( <u>http://u.uma.es/cZz/</u>)or decide, if they prefer, to participate in the International Staff Week organized by **UMA International HUB**.

Two editions will probably be organized:

A winter edition: early / mid February A spring edition: early/mid May.

Mobility should take place from November 2022 till July 2023 and finish by 31st July 2023.

#### 3.5. Nomination dates

The nomination and application period, depending of the period of the stay (from November 22-July, 23), will be:

11st October 2022-1st May 2023

The date of the mobility is conditionated to the fulfilment of the administrative procedure and visa issues.







# 4. Admission formality procedure to University of Málaga

At least 20 days before the start of their stay, the selected person should contact Universidad de Málaga through the email <a href="mailto:icm@uma.es">icm@uma.es</a> to start the admission process. The candidates should send the following documents:

- Grant Agreement signed by the applicant.
- Copy of the passport and visa if requested.
- Copy of travel and accident insurance policy, valid for the entire period of stay at Universidad de Málaga
- Flight ticket.
