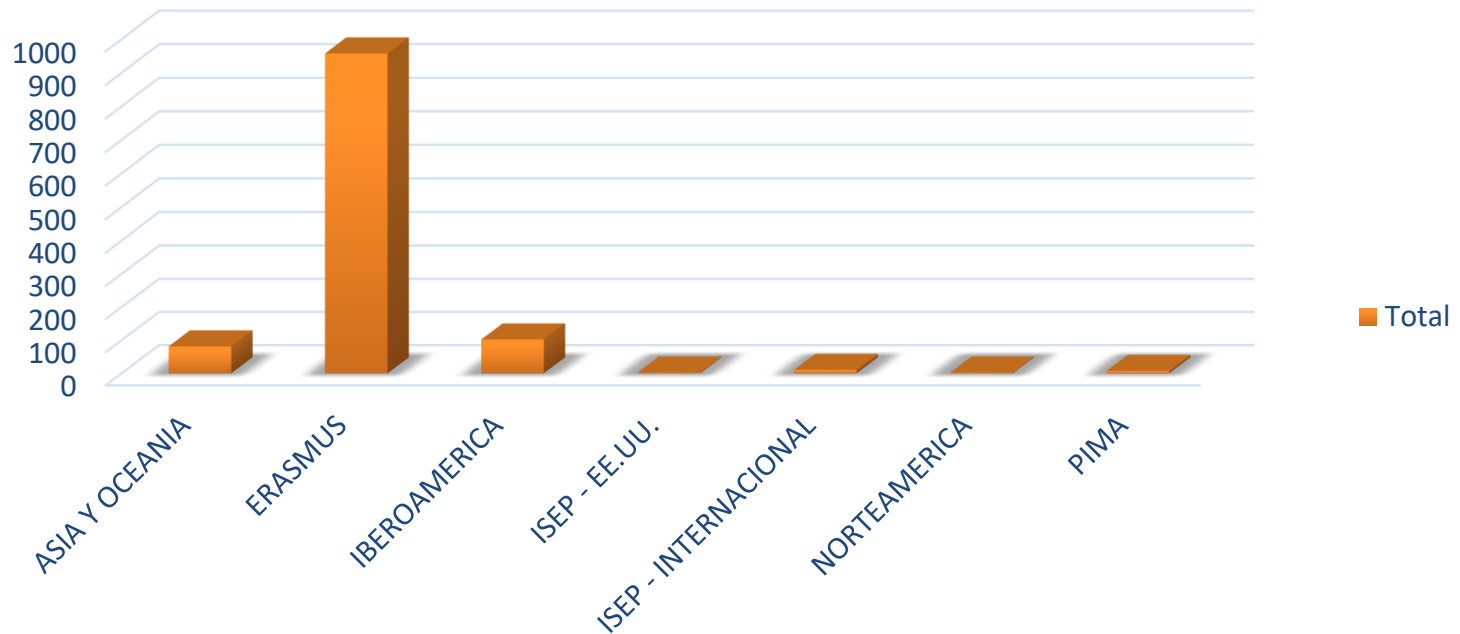

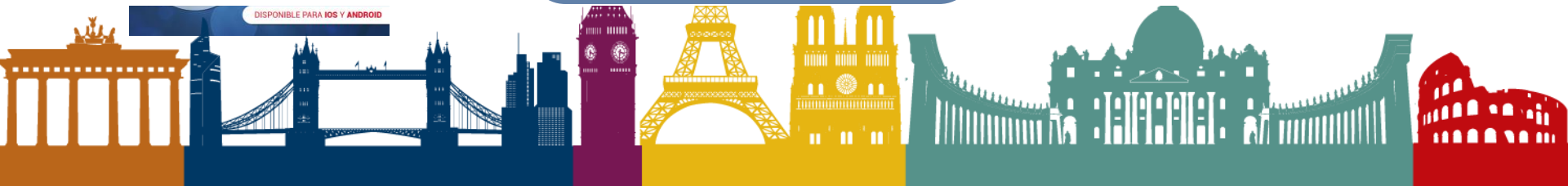

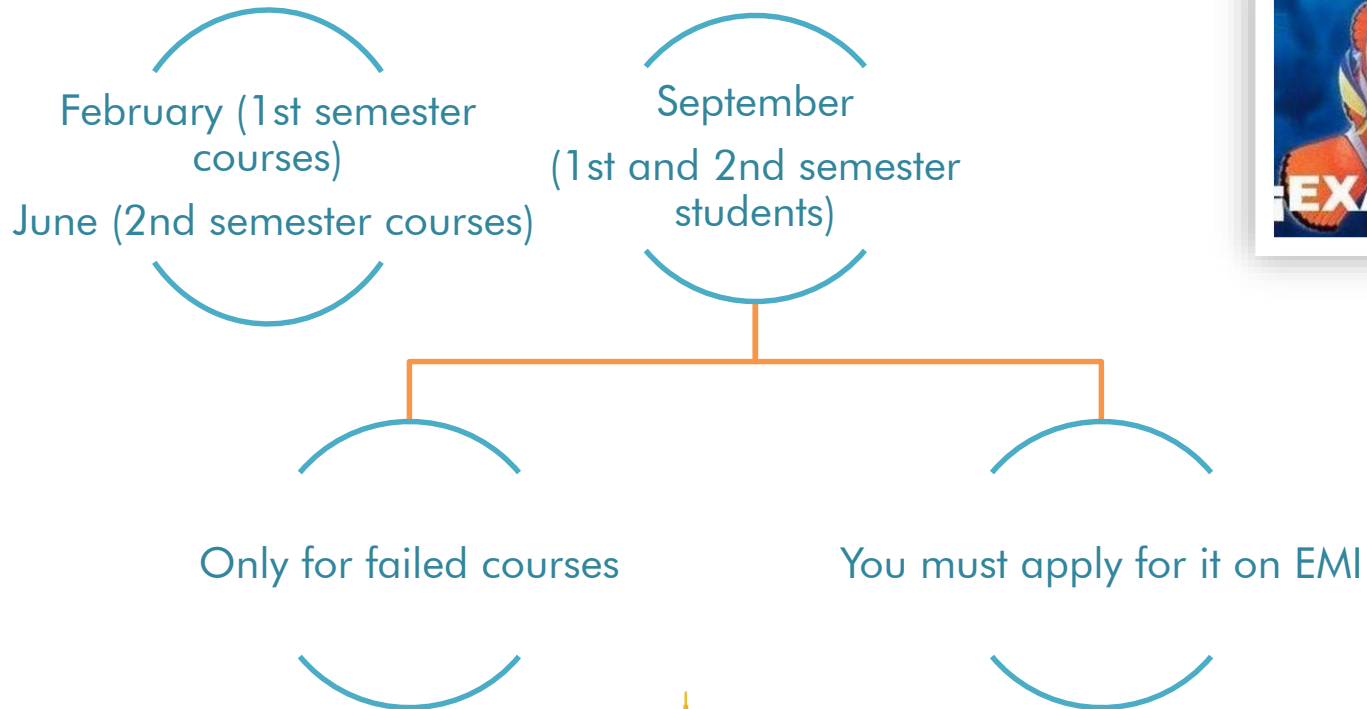

- Facilities at the UMA (campuses, faculties, libraries, canteens, sport complexes, etc.)



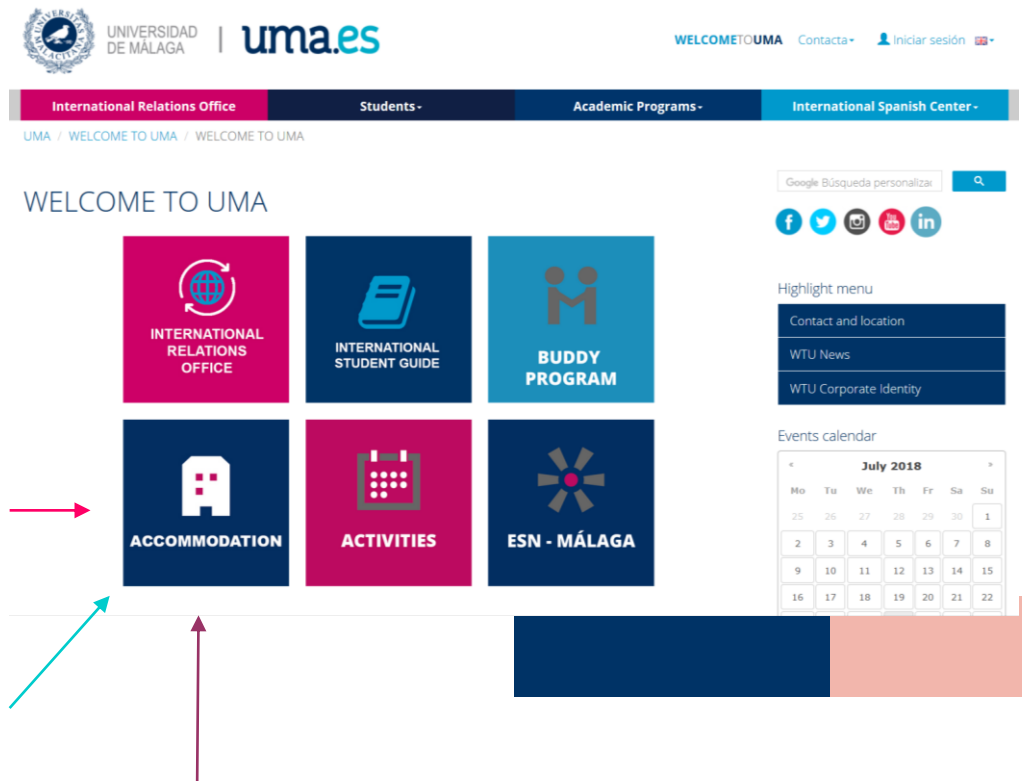

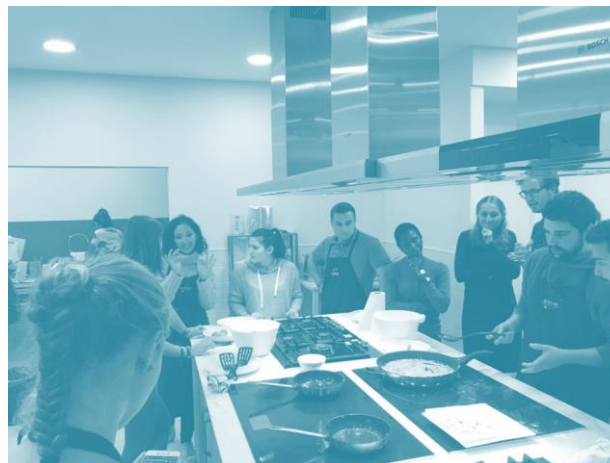
FLAMENCO WORKSHOPS

The exchanges are thematic and linked to the celebrations we have throughout the course. Additionally, the exchanges take place in different places according to the themes.





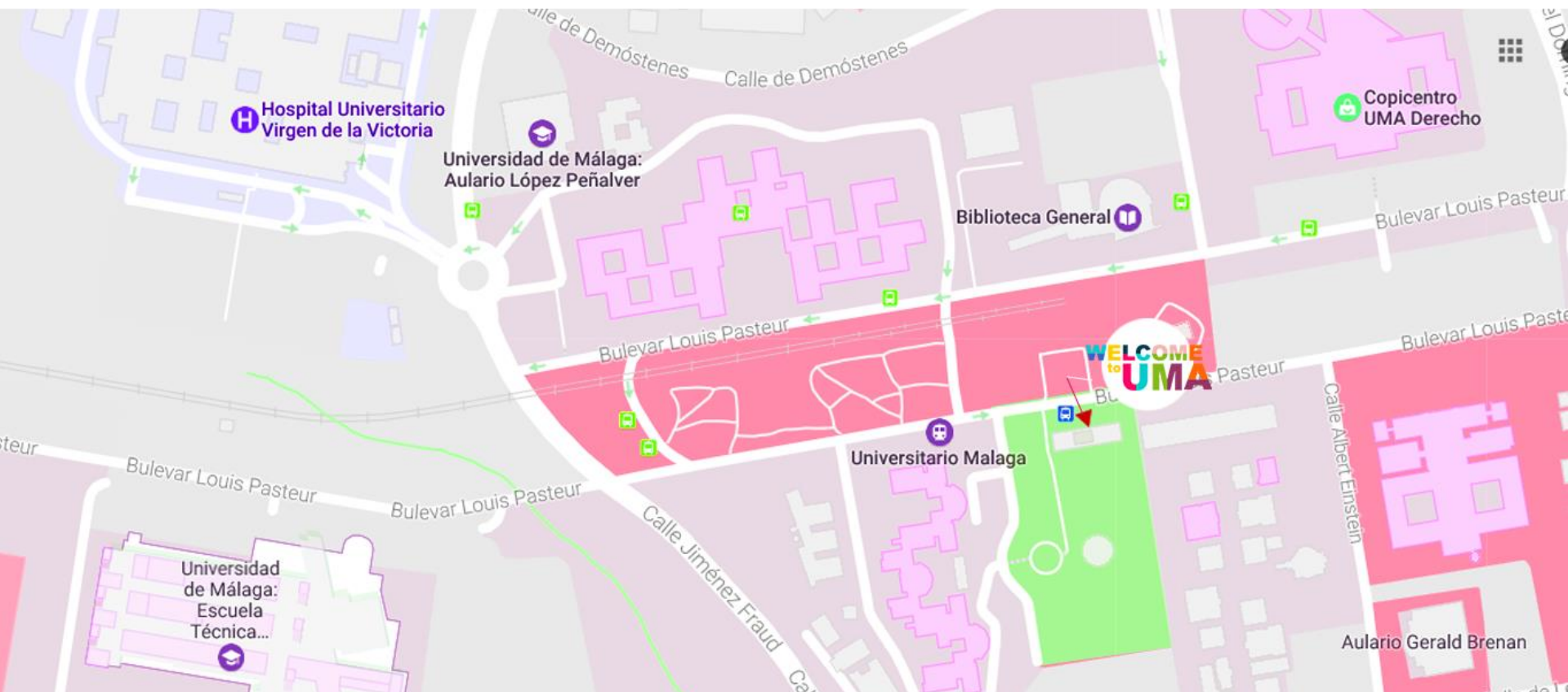

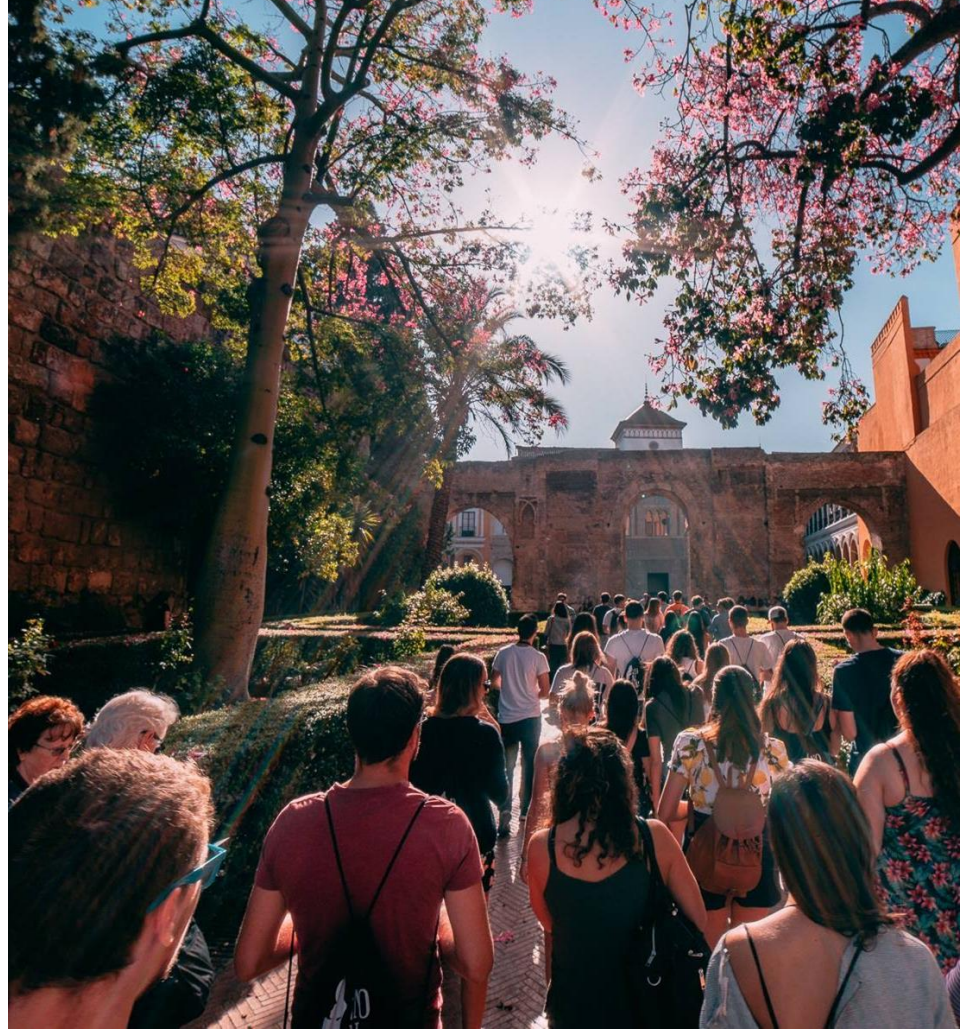

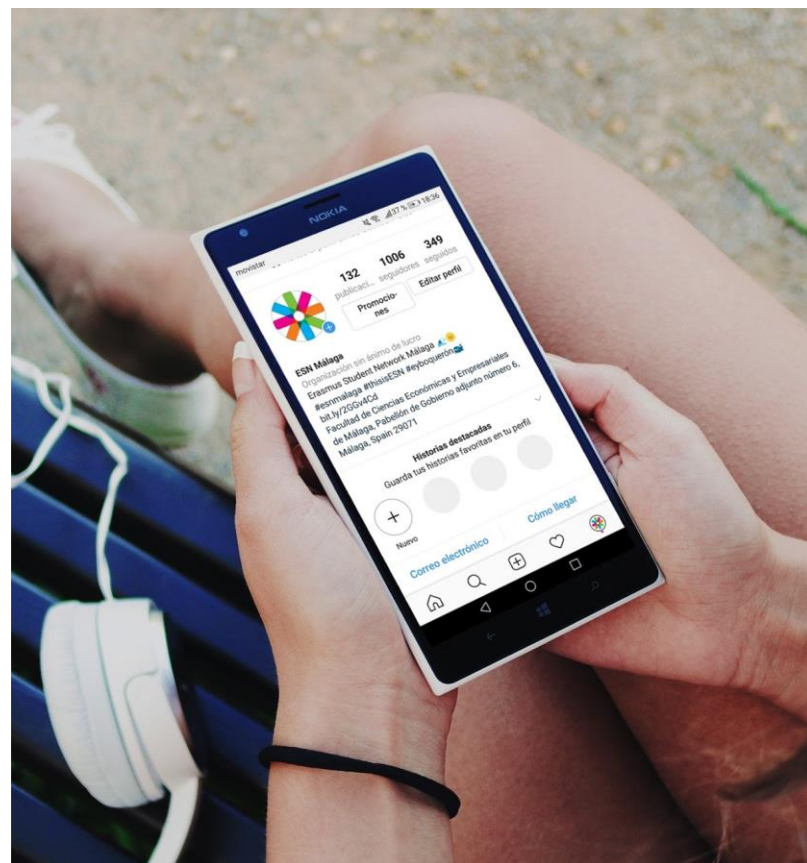

Most Frequent Crimes against foreigners

- * Surely, the most repeated crime in Malaga, which victims are foreigners is Petty Larceny.
- * The limit between Grand and Petty Larceny in Spain is 400€ (without violence neither intimidation)
- * Cellphones and wallets are the most stolen objects.



*Petty Larceny / Pickpockets

Petty Larcenies / Pickpockets Prevention Tips

- Don't let strangers get close to you.
- Carry only small amount of cash.
- Don't leave your mobile phone over the table in restaurants.
- Don't leave your stuff out of sight (e.g. bags in pub / club...; especially at the beach while you are swimming)
- Don't keep expensive stuff in your backpack.
- Distrust people selling flowers on the street.
- Distrust people who beg in restaurants.
- Increase these preventive measures if you're drunk; Thieves will take advantage of your state to rob you.

Petty Larcenies / Pickpockets Most Frequent Areas

- All downtown District
- Beaches (Malagueta, Misericordia)
- Seafront, Grass zone
- Alcazaba (arab fortress palace)
- Gibralfaro Castle
- Any crowded place

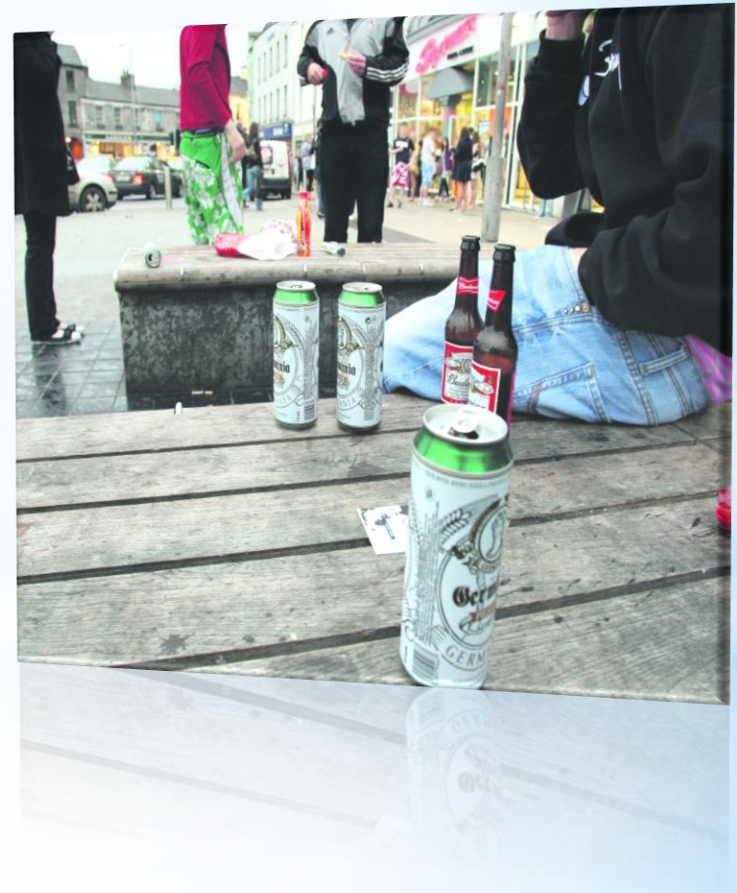


*If you exceed the noise limit you can be fined.

*Drink in the street

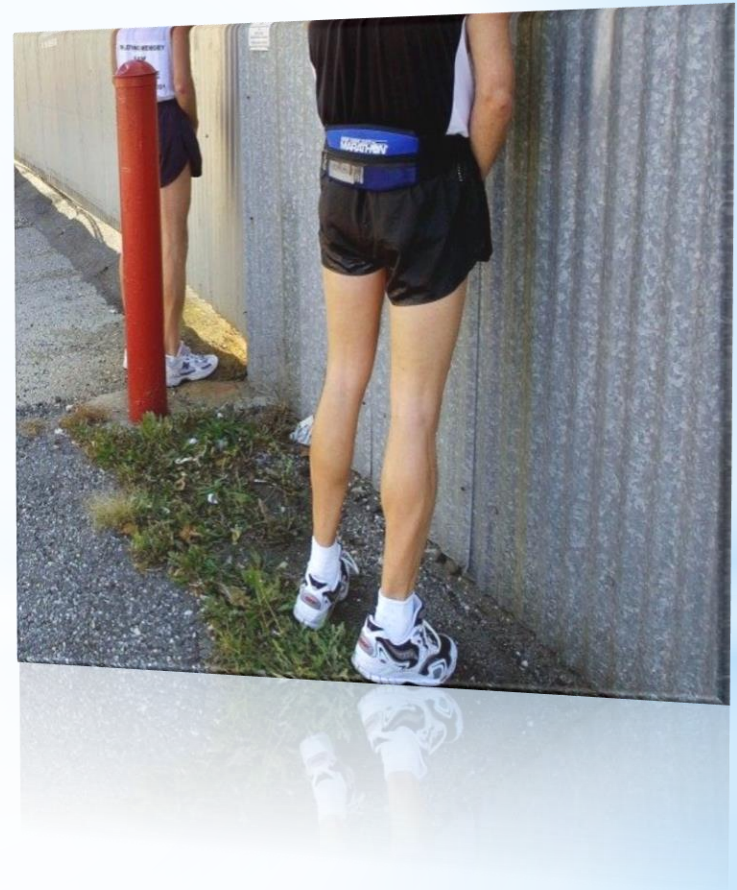
*Drug use is not allowed in Spain. You can be fined up to 600€.

*Drugs dealers can be arrested. It's a major crime, from 3 years of imprisonment.
