

APPENDIX I TO THE CORPORATE PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT IN ACTIVITIES OF GENERAL INTEREST SIGNED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MÁLAGA AND JOSÉ ANTONIO SIERRA LUMBRERAS (Sponsorship)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD

Article 1. Objetives

Mr. José Antonio Sierra Lumbreras and the University of Málaga, via the Aula María Zambrano de Estudios Transatlánticos UMA - ATECH, call the Spanish-Irish Awards of the Aula María Zambrano de Estudios Transatlánticos, which is part of the Centro de Estudios Iberoamericanos y Transatlánticos FGUMA-UMA (CEIT). The purpose of these awards is to encourage research and increase awareness of Spanish-Irish relations in all academic and scientific fields.

Artícle 2. Requirements for applicants

The competition is open to professors, students, journalists and researchers from all over the world.

Article 3. Requirements for submissions

- 1. The research papers to be submitted must relate to Spanish-Irish relations, which may be of a historical, economic, cultural or any other kind of study.
- 2. The report will at least include the following sections: title, abstract, key words, introduction, discussion, findings (if the nature of the work so requires), conclusions and bibliography.
- 3. The document must not be less than 150 pages in length. Annexes and the bibliography used and mentioned not included.
- 4. The text must be in Word format; font, Times New Roman 12; 1.5 line spacing; left and right margins of 3 cm; top and bottom margins of 2.5 cm, A4 page.
- 5. Papers may be written in Spanish or English
- 6. The papers should be unpublished and should not have won any previous awards.

Article 4. Endowment and amount

The total prize will be €1,200. The awards will be given as follows:

- 1.000€ for the best paper.
- Second prize of 200€ for the second best.



 An article of each of the awarded papers may be published for its international promotion in the TSN Journal.

Article 5. Application procedure

Applications should be sent by post to the Centro de Estudios Iberoamericanos y Transatlánticos FGUMA-UMA (CEIT):

Applications must be submitted up to nine months from the day following the publication of this call on the website www.uma.es/amzet.

Article 6. Evaluation of applications

Applications received in due time and form will be evaluated by a Selection Committee composed of:

- Director of the Centro de Estudios Iberoamericanos y Transatlánticos FGUMA-UMA (CEIT), or a person delegated by him/her.
- Two PhD professors from the University of Malaga
- The Aula María Zambrano de Estudios Transatlánticos International advisor.
- Two representatives of Irish universities or institutions.

Once the papers have been evaluated by the Selection Committee, the resolution will be published on the aforementioned website. The winners will be personally notified by e-mail as well. Non-compliance with the call, plagiarism, as well as concealment of data, alteration of data or any other manipulation made by the applicant, will be cause for rejection of the application.
