I belong to the teaching community of the University of Malaga (Spain) since October 2009, on a full-time basis, since 2019. The areas of Methodology and Health Psychology are my specialties. I am accredited for as contracted doctor since 2016 by the Andalusian Agency of knowledge. I have versatility and ability to adapt to teaching, which is demonstrated by the Teaching Quality Activity Reports of excellent ratings.

Until September 2019, I have combined two jobs: teacher at the university and a coordinator of the Psycho-oncology Unit of the health center Asociación for Breast Cancer Patients (ASAMMA), where I have also developed teaching duties, professionally tutored the external practices of Psychology Degree, and of the General Health Master for more than ten years.

Continuing with my facet as a health psychologist, since 2019 I cover one of the two collaboration positions as Psychologist of the Psychological Care Service of the University of Málaga, chosen by competitive concurrence through curricular merits.

I currently have several lines of research. The first one focuses on the health and well-being of women that are diagnosed with breast cancer, with several indexed publications in journals, with impact factor in Q-I category. The second line of research, is the prevention of child sexual abuse (CSA). In this matter, I have been principal investigator of a research project and have participated as a collaborating researcher on assessment and prevention of CSA on an additional research project. This line has also produced several publications in journals indexed with JCR in Q-I, and publications in international conferences and books of proceedings of these conferences. My dedication to clinical and health psychology as well as to university teaching gives me an ideal combination to carry out with greater scientific rigor the different investigations proposed in health psychology.
