







FACE-TO-FACE SPANISH COURSE

[€800] 1 month - 80 hours - 8 ECTS credits

The face-to-face Spanish course is a one-month intensive course with four hours of classes per day.

Students can take a short one-month Spanish programme, a programme lasting several months or an annual programme, depending on students' needs and interests.

Students will go up from sub-levels and levels according to their progress.

ONLINE SPANISH COURSE

[€342] 3 months- 40 hours - 4 ECTS credits


From March to May, 2024 From October to December, 2024

The online Spanish course is aimed at students who want to combine learning Spanish with their daily activities.

In this course, there are two/three hours of video conferences per week and one hour of support from teachers through the virtual campus.

The aim is to reach one of the levels or sublevels of Spanish in three months.

- » Certificate awarded by the University of Málaga
- » 2-3 hours of video conferences from Monday to Wednesday
- » 1 hour of teacher-led tasks per week
- » Small groups of 8 to 10 students
- » Access to the virtual campus of the University of Málaga
- » Interactive content and extra materials for the sublevel/level
- » Digital Textbook

DELE EXAM PREPARATION COURSES

[€200] **20 hours**

The DELE exam preparation courses are 20-hour courses in which students are given training to prepare for the official DELE exams at levels A2, B1, B2 and C1.

The course dates and timetable are adapted to the needs of the group.

There must be a minimum of 6 to 8 students of the same level for this course to be held.
